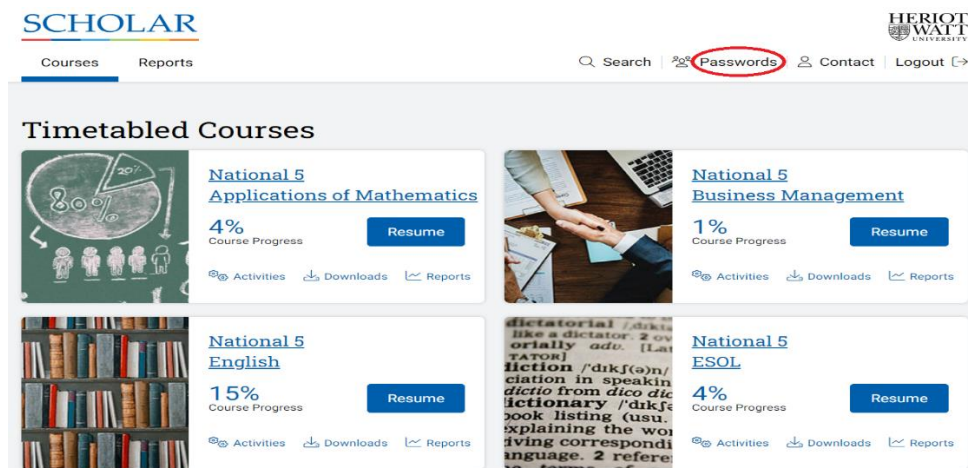


## Learner Enrolment Process

To enrol students into classes, two spreadsheets are required.

- SpreadsheetPupils  
*This provides class lists for the learners with one row per learner per course.*
- SpreadsheetStaff  
*This identifies the staff teaching each class with one row per teacher per class.*

School Scholar Contacts are required to upload spreadsheets directly into Scholar from within the Password Manager, accessed using the Passwords option at the top of their login screen.



To upload the spreadsheets, select the “Upload Spreadsheet” option and add the staff and student spreadsheets saved as a .xlsx file.

**\*\*\*\* TIP \*\*\* BEFORE UPLOADING SPREADSHEETS, PLEASE HIGHLIGHT THE SPREADSHEET AND SELECT DATA AND SORT BY COLUMN C – SUBJECT ID AND COLUMN H CLASS – this sorts both spreadsheets into the same order and you can quickly check that each subject and class are there, any missing should stand out.**

**Please do not add or remove columns, they must be returned in the same format for successful processing.**



## SpreadsheetPupils

For each course a student is studying, one row in **SpreadsheetPupils** must be completed.

Cohort	Identifies the teaching session	This should always be <b>"2026SCO"</b>
SchoolSQA	Unique school identifier	SQA Centre Number for your school
SubjectID	SQA Course Code	<b>SQA subject code, as a string, for the required course.</b> <b>**Spaces in the SQA subject code must be retained**.</b> <b>The list of valid codes is provided in the tab "List of Subject IDs".</b>
StudentSCN	Unique identifier for the student	The Student Candidate Number is the student's unique identifier. If the number is less than nine digits then it is padded with 0's in front of the number prior to being validated. The SCN is used as the Student's username.
StudentFirstName	Student's first name	This is limited to 50 characters and can include all alphanumeric characters, spaces and standard punctuation, <b>we cannot accept commas.</b>
StudentLastName	Student's last name	This is limited to 50 characters and can include all alphanumeric characters, spaces, and standard punctuation, <b>we cannot accept commas.</b>
StudentPassword	Student Password	<b>LEAVE BLANK</b>
Class	Class identifier	This is the name used to each class groups within a course.  For example, if there are three N5 Mathematics classes, they could be called: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• "1", "2" and "3"</li> </ul> or <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• "Class 1", "Class 2", "Class 3"</li> </ul> or <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• "WBSets1", "WBSets2", "KLSet1"</li> </ul> These class codes are then used in in the Teacher Spreadsheet to identify which teacher is teaching each class.
Year	Year group for student	S3, S4, S5 or S6
Status	Enrolment status of student	Enter <b>"1"</b> Pupil enrolled with your school Enter <b>"2"</b> Pupil attending your school who is enrolled at another school.
DateAdded	Date when the student was first registered	<b>LEAVE BLANK</b>

## SpreadsheetStaff

For each class, at least one row of **SpreadsheetStaff** must be completed.

If a class is taught by more than one teacher- a row must be included for each of the teachers who are teaching this class.

StaffID	Unique identifier for the teacher	<b>LEAVE BLANK</b>
StaffFirstName	Teacher's first name	This is limited to 50 characters and can include all alphanumeric characters, spaces and standard punctuation <b>we cannot accept commas. This must exactly match the teacher's first name in SEEMiS.</b>
StaffLastName	Teacher's last name	This is limited to 50 characters and can include all alphanumeric characters, spaces and standard punctuation <b>we cannot accept commas. This must exactly match the teacher's last name in SEEMiS.</b>
StaffPassword	Teacher's password	<b>LEAVE BLANK</b>
Class	Class identifier	This is the name used to each class groups within a course.  For example, if there are three Higher Mathematics classes, they could be called:  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• "1", "2" and "3"</li> </ul> or <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• "Class 1", "Class 2", "Class 3"</li> </ul> or <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• "WBSets1", "WBSets2", "KLSet1"</li> </ul> These class codes <u>must</u> match those used to identify classes in the Student Spreadsheet.
StaffEmail	Email address	Please enter staff school email address as it appears in SEEMiS.
PT	Principal Teacher flag	This field must contain a single digit number, either:  <b>1 = Principal Teacher or Faculty Head</b> <b>0 = Class Teacher</b>  In the reporting system, class teachers are able to view the progress of learners in the classes that they teach.  If a teacher needs to be able to track the progress of all learners within a certain subject, for example if they are a Principal Teacher or a Faculty Head, enter a "1" in this column.
DateAdded	Date when the student was first registered	<b>LEAVE BLANK</b>

## Example Spreadsheets

This example shows fully completed pupil and teacher spreadsheets for three different S4 classes.

- There are two National 5 Biology classes, one taught by Adam Smith (13 learners) and the other by Mary Ford (8 learners). Adam is the Principal Teacher of Biology and would like to be able to review the progress of all Biology classes.
- There is one National 5 Chemistry class (12 learners) taught by Mary Ford.
